The Roanoke/SW District, Associated General Contractors of Virginia is presently seeking applicants for their Scholarship Program for the 2010-2011 school year. Applicable award information and eligibility criteria are set forth below:

• **AWARD INFORMATION** •

- 1) A successful applicant may retain eligibility for future scholarship awards by continuing to meet all eligibility requirements and by providing proof of class completion with a minimum average grade of C.
- 2) The scholarship check will be presented to the recipient's school for the Fall 2009 semester.

• **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS** •

- 1) Applicant must either now be enrolled in or planning to pursue a construction related curriculum through a vocational school, technical school or college. Priority will be given to those applicants considering a trade related education (e.g. carpentry, masonry, plumbing).
- 2) Applicant must be an immediate family member of an employee of a Roanoke/SW District AGC firm or personally employed by such a firm, or a student enrolled in the Vocational Industrial Clubs of America (VICA) program.
- 3) Applicant is responsible for ensuring that the application form is returned to the Roanoke/SW District AGC by **October 1st, 2010**.
- 4) All finalists may be interviewed by the Roanoke/SW District AGC Scholarship Committee.
